John 13:1-20

Introduction: Today we will see an infinitely great example of humility and be called to follow. How can the God of the universe wash the dirty feet of His followers? How about washing the feet of Judas who was His betrayer? How about the God of the Universe washing your feet?

The extent of Jesus' love (vs. 1)

Five humility principles learned at Jesus' Feet

1. Real humility lays aside pretense or position.
2. Real humility doesn't need to be announced.
3. Real humility is not a sign of weakness but of strength.
4. Real humility is inclusive.
5. Real humility comes from a person who knows who he is.
