An Unlikely Woman Meets the Messiah *John 4:1-24*

Introduction: Today our study in John takes us to another one of those personal conversations with Jesus. This time it is not at night in private with a highly respected man. This time Jesus sits down at a public well at mid-day with a woman of questionable reputation.

At this well Jesus offers a different kind of drink than what the world offers. Just one sip of this water is so vital, so transforming and so satisfying that it quenches the deepest thirst.
