

Jesus has Power Over Time

John 4:46-54

Introduction: What evidence is there that validates Jesus as the Messiah, the Son of God? What proof is there to conclude that Jesus is the Savior of the world? Is there a “smoking gun” that verifies the true identity of Jesus? The apostle John anticipated that probing question. He wrote his gospel so that anyone wanting to investigate the truth would come to the right conclusion. John wanted us to understand that Jesus is the Messiah.

John’s Reason for Writing:

“But these things are written that you may believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, and that by believing you may have life in his name.” (John 20:31)

The Setting (vs. 43-46a):

“So he came again to Cana in Galilee”

The Need (vs. 46b-47):

“And at Capernaum there was an official whose son was ill. ...he was at the point of death.”

The Miracle (vs. 48-52):

“Jesus said to him, ‘Go; your son will live.’”

The Response (vs. 53):

“So he and all his household believed.”

What Does This Miracle Mean to You?

1. Allow desperation and pressing need to motivate you to seek Jesus, find Him and ask Him.
2. Problems are the proving grounds of your faith.
3. Trust God before you see the results.
4. Jesus overcomes every obstacle.
5. Your faith or lack of it impacts others.
