The Problem of Perpetual Infant Christians

1 Corinthians 3:1-9

Some believers in the church remain in perpetual infancy. (vs. 1)

The four marks of Spiritual Infancy: (vs. 1-5)

- 1. Perpetual spiritual infants never grow beyond a baby's spiritual diet. (vs. 2)
- 2. Perpetual spiritual infants are dominated by their old fleshly nature. (vs. 3a)
- 3. Perpetual spiritual infants incite troubled interpersonal relationships. (vs. 3)
- 4. Perpetually spiritual infants live no different than unbelievers. (vs. 3-4)

Seven signs of Christians growing into maturity:

- 1. Spiritually mature believers do not make idols of other Christian leaders. (vs. 5)
- 2. Spiritually mature believers care most about what God is doing in the world. (vs. 6-7)
- 3. Spiritually mature believers enjoy and encourage the diversity of gifts in ministry. (vs. 6)
- 4. Spiritually mature believers work as one with other believers. (vs. 8)
- 5. Spiritually mature believers give God credit for what God is doing. (vs. 6)
- 6. Spiritually mature believers are partners in God's growth plans. (vs. 6, 9)
- 7. Spiritually mature believers live in expectation of Christ's return and Christ's reward. (vs. 8a)
