2. What are the four provisions of the Abrahamic Covenant? Why do you think God gave it to them as an unconditional covenant?
3. What did God say would happen to the Jews if they failed to follow Him?
Deuteronomy 4:25-27; Ezekiel 12:15; Jeremiah 9:16; Ezekiel 22:15
4. How long were the Jews scattered throughout the world? What happened on May 14, 1948?
5. Based on what unconditional promises did God predict that the Jews would finally be returned to their land? *Deuteronomy 4:30-31; Isaiah 11:11-12*
6. Will Israel's promised re-gathering happen during a time of peace or under considerable crisis?

1. When you read Ezekiel 37:1-14 what modern human catastrophe did Ezekiel foresee that would spark the rebirth of Israel?
2. Why is the “never again” prediction of Amos 9:14-15 crucial in understanding the last days? Based on this Scripture do you think Israel will be “driven into the Mediterranean” by Iran’s radical clerics?
3. When Jesus comes again will the Jews at that time believe Jesus is their Messiah?

4. Do you think that America should continue to be a friend to the nation of Israel?
5. Pastor Jerry has often said to Jews: “The best friends of Jews and the nation of Israel are Bible-believing Christians?” Do you agree? Why or why not?
