1. Given the subject of Psalm 90, at what point in Moses' life do you think he wrote this Psalm?
2. In what ways do you think of God as your present and ultimate "dwelling place"?
3. According to verse 1 is God immanent? Does God involve Himself in the present affairs of mankind?
4. According to verse 2 is God transcendent? Does God exist outside of time and is He greater than all He has created?
5. Why is it important to understand and believe these two contrasting yet complimentary divine characteristics?
6. How is "man in the time zone" described in verses 3-6?
7. How is God described in those same verses?

8. Moses learned to respect and even fear of God for His holiness, greatness and power because he witnessed God's miracles at the Red Sea, at Sinai and during the wilderness wanderings. What did Moses learn about God that is reflected in verses 7-8?

### **Growing Stronger**

1. There is a deep sigh in the words of verses 9-10. What realities do you see in these verses about man in the time zone?
2. What is the main lesson Moses is trying to pass along in verse 12? Do you receive Moses' counsel?
3. In what ways can you live more wisely than you currently live?
4. How would believing verse 14 help you start your day more wisely?
5. Verse 17 is a prayer that God would "establish the work of our hands." If you could ask God for success at doing something that would last for eternity what would it be?
