Let's Get Started:

Jesus' ministry began in a great battle with Satan that lasted forty days (Luke 4:2). As Jesus' ministry neared its end, Satan again attacked Him in the Garden of Gethsemane with such force that the Bible shows us great drops of blood came out of the pores of Jesus' skin (22:44).
