Scripture Passage: 1 John 2:3-6

Have you ever known someone who seemed to exhibit obedience but ended up abandoning the faith? What is the difference? (1 John 2:19)
Why would God want us to be obedient as a way of our showing our love for Him?
Discuss your understanding of abiding in Christ. Use John 15 for additional truths on the subject.
