- 3. Find at least one scripture in your Bible that confirms the fact that God is eternal.
- 4. Find at least one scripture in your Bible that confirms the fact that God is love.

5.	If God is eternal and if He is love, who was there for Him to love before there was anything or anybody outside of Himself to love?
6.	Has God ever been "alone" or "lonely?" Because of His Triune nature, when God loved Himself, who else was He loving, and who else was loving Him?

_	Christians who love each other are supernaturally equipped to do so. Study Galatians 5:13-15. Pay careful attention to this passage: But if you bite and devour one another, watch out that you are not consumed by one another (Galatians 5:15).
	How do Christians "bite and devour" one another, and why?
	Do you see this happening in the church today? (Not your particular church, but the global sense of the word "church.")
	Is it ever going to end? How do we, as individuals, influence the church to love one another the way "Christ loved the church and gave Himself up for her" (Ep. 5:25)?
8.	According to John 15, what is the secret ingredient that keeps us connected to the love of Christ?
9.	If all believers are staying connected to Christ, in close proximity, abiding in Him, how might this have a positive influence on the degree to which believers in the body of Christ love another and have less "biting and devouring" of each other?

10. In 1 John verses 17 and 18, John claims that perfect love casts out fear. Fear of what?

Find at least one scripture that gives you confidence that there is no need to fear death if you are a true born-again disciple of Jesus.
