The Day of the Lord, Part 1

1 Thessalonians 5:1-11

Jesus warned His disciples five times in the Olivet Discourse to be ready because He could come at any moment.

Jesus taught His disciples to avoid falling into two opposite traps:

- 1. The Parable of the Servants teaches us that some people will be UNPREPARED when Jesus comes. Matthew 24:45-51
- 2. The Parable of the Wise and Foolish Virgins teaches us that ONLY PREPARED disciples will enter the wedding feast of the Kingdom. Matthew 25:1-13

When the end times come, the expectant church will be fully prepared for the rapture but the unbelieving world will be completely unprepared. (vs. 5:1-5)

The "Day of the Lord" is not a literal 24 hour day but a period of time when God will move the affairs of world history to their final consummation.

The Day of the Lord spans a time that begins with the rapture of the church and ends at the beginning of eternity when God creates a new heaven and earth.

The expectant Church welcomes the Day of the Lord, the unbelieving world will dread it. (vs. 5:1-6)

The unbelieving and the unprepared world will dread the Day of the Lord.
