- 1. The anti-Christ will rise to power on the promise of international peace and security. (1 Thess. 5:2,3)
- 2. The anti-Christ will have great supernatural powers. (vs. 9)
- 3. The anti-Christ will control personal identity, movement and all buying and selling. (Rev. 13:16-18)
- 4. The anti-Christ will promote worldwide drug use to make people compliant. (Rev. 18:23)
- 5. The anti-Christ will hold on to power through intimidation. (Rev. 13:4-5)
