Matthew 21:1-17

Today, let's look at Jesus's two major arrivals – A look back and a look forward

What do we know about Christ's coming into Jerusalem on Palm Sunday?

Fact #1 - The details of Christ's arrival were prophesied in great detail.

Fact #2 - Palm Sunday fulfilled God's promise to send Jesus to the Jews as their Messiah.

Fact #3 - The Jews misidentified Jesus because they didn't listen to him. (Matthew 21:10)

Fact #4 - Jesus wept over Jerusalem because He knew that the Jews would reject Him as their Messiah. (Matt. 23:37)

Fact #5 - The rejection by the Jews opened salvation's door for all nations. (Romans 11:11)

What does the Bible say about God's future plans for the world before Jesus comes again?

Fact #1 - Jesus prophesied His second coming in great detail. (Matthew 24)

Fact #2 – The Rapture of the church is the next event in God's future plans. (1 Thess. 4:16-17)

Fact #3 – World conditions signal that the return of the Lord is near.

Fact #4 – Jesus is coming soon. It is time to turn from sin, believe in Jesus and receive Him as Savior and Lord. (Acts 4:12)
