What are the roles of the Holy Trinity in providing salvation?

- 1. The Father loves the world and sends the Son.
- 2. The Son gives His life as an all-sufficient sacrifice for sin and rises from the dead.
- 3. The Holy Spirit comes in fulfillment of Christ's promise and applies the blessings of Christ's atonement to individuals.

The Holy Spirit's Work in Applying Salvation.

- 1. Conviction of sin, righteousness and judgment. (John 16:7-11)
- 2. Illumination to see and understand God's gracious offer in the gospel. (1 Corinthians 2:12-14)
- 3. Regeneration: Unworthy sinners locked in an unending cycle of sin are given a new nature. (John 3:5)
- 4. Call: Grace to obey the Holy Spirit's call to repentance and confession of faith. (John 6:44)
- 5. Indwell the believer: Holy Spirit takes up permanent residence in a believer's body. (1 Corinthians 6:19-20)
- 6. Filling: Living a surrendered life under the control of the Holy Spirit. (Ephesians 5:15-18)
- 7. Power to witness (Acts 1:9)
