

# Behold!: God is Triune

Genesis 1:1; Deuteronomy 6:4; Isaiah 6:8  
Matthew 3:16-17; 28:19-20; 2 Corinthians 13:14

**Truth #1: Behold! There is only one God! (Deuteronomy 6:4)**

**Truth #2: God's triune nature is progressively revealed in the Bible, starting with the first verse of Genesis.  
(Genesis 1:1)**

**Truth #3: The Bible reveals God as a Trinity of three co-equal persons.**

**Truth #4: Each of the three persons of the Godhead is unique in terms of His distinctive role.**

**Truth #5: The apostles and the early church fathers held the doctrine of the Trinity.**

**Truth #6: We cannot fully comprehend the depth of the doctrine of the Trinity.**

**Truth #7: We should reject all forms of false teaching about God that deny the Trinity.**

## **Conclusion:**

1. God is one and He is knowable; therefore, we should get to know Father, Son and Holy Spirit through the means He has ordained.
2. God is infinitely beyond our ability to fully comprehend Him, so we should humble ourselves, worship Him, and glory in His greatness.
3. The church should recite the Christian creeds that carefully and correctly describe God.
