6. Power to keep you from falling into sin and away from God. (Jude 24-25)
7. Power to take authority over Satan and his demons. (Luke 10:19-20)
8. Power to pray and believe God for the impossible. (James 5:16)
9. Power to never give up but keep looking ahead in hope. (Philippians 3:20-21)
10. Power to worship God now and in heaven for all eternity. (Revelation 19:1)
