Is God's Goodness For Real?

James 1:17-18

Introduction: When bad things happen, like a pandemic, many people instinctively wonder if God had anything to do with it. When good things happen, they quickly forget God and take credit.

At the foundation of staying real in life is our understanding of God.

James 1:16-18 gives us three powerfully positive declarations about the character of God.

- **1.** God is Good vs. 16-17 "Do not be deceived, my beloved brothers. Every good and perfect gift is from above, coming down from the Father of the heavenly lights."
- 2. God is ALWAYS Good vs. 17 "Every good and perfect gift is from above, coming down from the Father of the heavenly lights, who does not change like shifting shadows."
- 3. God proved his goodness through giving sinners the new birth *vs. 18* "He chose to give us birth through the word of truth, that we might be a kind of first-fruits of all He created."

Three wonderful evidences of God's goodness in redemption.

- 1. God's motivation was His sovereign grace. "He CHOSE TO GIVE us birth."
- 2. God's method was "through the WORD OF TRUTH."
- 3. God's ultimate plan was to make us "first-fruits of all He created."

The greatest gift God ever gave to sinful men is the free gift of eternal life through Jesus Christ His Son.

Conclusion: Four ways to acknowledge God's goodness.

- 1. Look to God if you desire to live the best possible life. Matthew 6:33 But seek first the kingdom of God and his righteousness, and all these things will be added to you.
- 2. Thank God every day for His blessings. 1 Thess. 5:18 *Give thanks in all circumstances; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you.*
- 3. In times of testing, remember that your troubles are only temporary and light compared to what God has planned for you. 2 Corinthians 4:17 For this light momentary affliction is preparing for us an eternal weight of glory beyond all comparison.
- 4. To experience God's greatest goodness, receive God's greatest gift, salvation through faith in Jesus Christ. 2 Cor. 9:15 *Thanks be to God for his inexpressible gift!*
